I would like to inform you of a breakthrough in the energy saving and rail transportation field. Sky Train is a National Climate Change solution fitting many Smart Growth/Transit Oriented Projects such as Destiny at Yeehaw Junction.

After being reviewed by consultants of the National Science Foundation, Grand Canyon "Parks", and Orlando Airport this technology was short listed as meeting their criteria.

In 2003 the Sky Train team built a computerized model that was displayed at FDOT's Transplex 2003 event; funded by Florida's Technological Research Development Authority. Their elevated system mitigates the need for cost prohibitive subways.

I support these patented systems with 63 unique claims effecting transportation improvement. Sky Train serves passengers by using a rearrangement of standard rail components. They aim to reduce structure and operating costs by incorporating automation.

It is a solution for crossing the campus of USF and their Center for Urban Transportation Research. I also remind you that it is on the path of the Hillsborough transit plan since 1993 and an ultimate solution for Pinellas's needs requested since 1973.
